


FAQs



Vanderbilt Baseball performed remarkably last year—both on the field and in the classroom. This past season, ten of our student-athletes were named to the SEC Academic Honor Roll. As a team, the VandyBoys advanced to an NCAA Super Regional for the 7th time in 9 years after an impressive showing throughout the Clemson Regional. Connor Kaiser was named to the 2018 SEC All-Defensive Team and recognized as one of four shortstop finalists for the Rawlings Gold Glove, while Zach King was named to the SEC Community Service Team. Six Commodores, including third-round picks Connor Kaiser and Reid Schaller, advanced to the professional ranks through the 2018 MLB Draft.
